- Then, pass the city squares of Piazza Municipio and Piazza Plebiscito, the Castle Nuovo and the San Carlo Opera House, and the Villa Comunale Park before arriving at the Pizzeria.
- Next, experience what Naples is most famous for—the pizza—during a visit to an authentic Neapolitan pizzeria, and enjoy lunch here (included in the price of the tour).

- Start your sightseeing heading to St. Angel's Castle, the ancient Rome Papal fortress (outside visit); drive through Via dei Coronari, the reign of antique shops; snap a picture in front of the world-famous "Fountain of the Four Rivers" with its magnificent Egyptian obelisk in Piazza Navona, the most beautiful baroque square in Rome with masterpieces by Bernini and Borromini; continue to the Pantheon, an exquisite example of ancient Roman architecture, next visit Trevi Fountain, the most famous and spectacular fountain in Rome. Throw a coin into the fountain and "ensure your return to Rome."
- Conclude the Segway ride back at the Vatican Area and enjoy approximately 4 hours of free time to explore on foot.
