During the trip, receive helpful information about Florence from a highly knowledgeable tour escort and plan your day. Note: A tour escort will be on the coach to and from Florence to provide narration, maps and emergency phone numbers.

Explore famous landmarks such as Santa Croce Square and the Uffizi Gallery (entry fee, long lines may be experienced) Shop in the built-in stores of the Ponte Vecchio bridge and see the Cathedral di Saint Maria del Fiore known as "Il Duomo". Art fans can visit the Accademia di Belle Arti Museum and discover Michelangelo's legendary "David" statue (entry fee, long lines may be experienced).

Take a scenic 2.5-hour drive (approximate) through Tuscany to Florence. Take a 2.5-hour walking tour including Piazza Santa Croce with its classic Franciscan Basilica and Piazza della Signoria (external visit only), dominated by the

ranciscan Basilica and Piazza della Signoria (external visit only), dominated by the crenellated towers of the Palazzo Vecchio and the Uffizi Gallery (external visit only). Stroll across the Ponte Vecchio Bridge with its built-in shops and reach the Cathedral Saint Maria del Fiore (external visit only), the iconic cathedral, famous for its Brunelleschi cupola known as "Il Duomo" and its ornate bronze doors called "The Gates of Paradise." Enter the Accademia di Belle Arti Museum with its multitude of priceless works. On one floor find the original plaster model for the "Ratto della Sabine" by Giambologna. In a separate hall, observe incomplete works by Michelangelo, which give invaluable insight into the artist's process, and experience the masterpiece, "David." Note: For security reasons, large backpacks are discouraged. You will be asked to leave them on the motor coach. Photos and films are not allowed inside the Accademia Museum allowed inside the Accademia Museum.

Enjoy an authentic Italian lunch at a local restaurant (included in the price of this tour).

Have approximately 75 minutes of free time for shopping or independent sightseeing.

Drive 2 hours through the Tuscan countryside before reaching Torre a Cenaia. A tour escort will accompany you and provide narration along the way.

Immerse yourself in the quintessential image of Tuscany seen in many movies, complete with olive and fruit trees surrounding the estate.

Be welcomed by your host and the chef, don your apron and prepare for an unforgettable day in a real Italian kitchen.

Discover the secrets for the preparation of "Pasta all'uovo" (homemade pasta) and make your "focaccia," which your chef has prepped for you early in the morning and prepare the

tomato sauce. Also prepare your dessert, a traditional Tuscan recipe: "Cantucci Toscani."

Enjoy an aperitif and wine with your "just made" focaccia (juice for children under 21 years of age). Visit the modern wine cellars, see how the wine production follows today's rhythms and enjoy the garden before lunch is served.

Your guide will explain the art of pairing food with wine as you taste local wines, specifically matched to your meal.

After lunch, enjoy a relaxing tour of the estate on an ancient cart. Discover the vineyards as 2 horses lead you through the 500 hectares of the estate. Along the way, learn about the grapes and keep your eye out for royal wild duck, hares and pheasants. Guests must advise of any food allergies or dietary requirements at the time of booking. All food and drinks are included.

Wheelchairs (collapsible or electric) are not permitted.

Guests are provided with an apron; however, please note that their clothes may become dirty during food preparation. Guests are encouraged to bring credit cards or currency to purchase optional extras such as souvenirs.

Take a 60-minute boat ride (approximate) past the villages named the "Cinque Terre" 5 small towns that seem frozen in time. Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site, these historic villages are brimming with old stone walls, winding paths, enchanting beaches and buildings that pepper the rocky cliffs. First stop will be the village of Vernazza, where you can admire the elaborate architecture, a remnant of times when the city was under Genoese rule. Note: Depending on sea conditions, the cruise portion of the excursion may be substituted with a motor coach tour. If this is the case, you will visit Riomaggiore instead of Vernazza and will walk along the "Passeggiata dell'Amore" (Lovers' Promenade') to reach the village of Manarola. If the tour is changed, it will involve an additional 1.5 miles of walking.

After an hour of guided exploration descend back to the port, and take a short 10-minute cruise to the town of Monterosso. This historic city lies on the summit of the hill of San Cristoforo, which separates the town into the old and new. On your 45-minute walking tour, wander the quaint winding streets as your guide

shows you the points of interest. Enjoy approximately 30 minutes of free time.
